The following materials can be printed out and used to keep a record of your reading and discipleship experience. They are designed to help you help your youngster to read deep and mine every treasure, then save it in writing, marking the value of the reading experience. This exercise trains the child in the application of critical thought and heightened discernment—crucial skills for Christian growth.

How To Use This Story Chats Resource Companion

- You'll need a ½ inch 3-ring binder and 3-hole punch. If you have a clear view cover on your binder, slip the cover of this e-book into the pocket.
- Print out a set of My Chapter Report for each of the 9 chapters in *Jamie's Journey*.
- Print out the My Story Illustration and Color Sheets for each chapter.
- Print out about two or three My New Words sheets and the Word Search.
- Assemble your binder after 3-hole punching all the pages.
- Depending on the academic skills of your child, have them fill out the My Chapter Report for each chapter as you work through your Story Chat

Discussion after reading. If they can write it themselves, have them do so. Otherwise, have your child dictate their answers and you write what they say on the report.

- Fill out the My New Words sheet as you work through each chapter. Make additional sheets as needed. Challenge your child to use the new words in speaking or writing and take ownership of an expanded vocabulary.
- Have your child color the Color Sheet. Encourage them to look closely at the illustration for unusual details and discuss what you find.
- Have your child find the exact line in the story that is illustrated in the Color Sheet and write it on the back of the sheet.
- Challenge your child to choose another scene from the chapter and try to sketch it themselves on the My Story Illustration.
- Complete the Word Search. The Answer Key is on the last page.
- Review what you have learned together when the story is done and take some time to thank the Lord for His goodness—touching your hearts through the power of story.

NOTE: Some material in this *Story Chats Resource Companion* is reformatted from my 26-week Literacy Journals available in hard copy book form.

Literacy Journals for elementary boys and girls and secondary academic levels encourage reading and recording of materials read. Students can see, over the period of an academic year, how their reading, vocabulary, composition, critical thought, and comprehension improves when a discipline of reading and writing is built.

Homeschool families find this tool invaluable for record keeping. As a record of learning, students will enjoy looking back to remember when they experienced a story and how they understood it at an earlier time in their life. A precious keepsake, indeed.










